a basketball court—and of course, the swimming pool with a diving board and high dive!



The Sacramento Public Library is seeking teenagers aged 14-19 to take on the role of Library Program Coordinators for Lunch at any one of their 14 libraries this summer. This opportunity involves collaborating with a team to offer free meals and activities to young people and families in the local area.

Details of the position:

- Responsible for ordering, receiving, and distributing meals
- Document and submit program details
- Ensure compliance with library and food partner rules and procedures
- Organize activities for lunch participants
- Provide necessary materials to volunteers
- Administer, collect, and analyze evaluation surveys
- A \$1,000 scholarship will be granted at the end of the program

The positions will last eight weeks from June 17 through August 9, with a 60-hour commitment required. Work shifts will be from Tuesday to Friday each week, from 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. (Shifts may vary.) Visit the SacLibrary website to learn more.
